NATIONAL CODE OF CONDUCT

You are reminded that the purpose of this Code is to provide an enjoyable and safe sporting environment, where your child is able to gain personal fulfilment and satisfaction through friendly competition.



ALL PARENTS/SPECTATORS SHOULD:

- **SUPPORT** your child and team in a positive manner.
- **NEVER** let match disappointment cause a loss of control.
- **NEVER** use abusive language with your team, the opposition or supporters.
- **NEVER** sledge the referee, players or supporters.
- **REALISE** that we don't need to blame anyone for a defeat.
- **REALISE** that the most important part of playing Rugby League is for the development – both physical and in character – of your child.
- Be **POSITIVE** with your child after a match – **WIN, LOSE** or **DRAW**.
- **ENCOURAGE** your child to avoid illegal/foul play and display **GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP**.
- **REALISE** that abusive comments and inappropriate behaviour can lead to ill-discipline on the field.

REMEMBER:

Breaching this Code of Conduct may result in:

1. You being approached by the Ground Manager or Club Official
2. You being asked to leave the ground (You will face a Club inquiry)
3. Police may be called
4. Your child may be excluded from playing Rugby League
